
SHABBAT

Wine

Wine was produced by Noah after the flood. It represents the potential and the blessings we all have in our lives.

Baruch atah, Adonai Eloheinu, Melech haolam, borei p'ri hagafen.

Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of the universe, Creator of the fruit of the vine.

Bread

The custom of having two loaves of Challah is to remind us of the double portion of Manna that the people of Israel received from God in the desert on Shabbat.

Baruch atah, Adonai Eloheinu, Melech haolam, hamotzi lechem min haaretz.

Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of the universe, who brings forth bread from the earth.
